Motorkhana Day

Sunday, 14th July 2019 at the Sydney Motor Sport Park Skid Pan

This information sheet is intended as a summary of information regarding the MX-5 Club Motorkhana. For full details, please consult the Supplementary Regulations available from the MX-5 Club of NSW website.

The motorkhana will be held on the skid pan at Sydney Motor Sport Park (SMSPP). Entry to the facility is via Gate 7 off Ferrers Road in Eastern Creek.

Entrants must either show a CAMS License (L2NS(J), L2S(J) or better) and a car club membership card, or have indicated on their entry form that they require a CAMS L1 license for the day. An Australian Auto-Sport Alliance (AASA) license is not acceptable for this event.

The motorkhana activities will be selected to not be hard on your vehicles, so bring your MX-5 or family hack, but preferably your MX-5 as they are great for motorkhanas.

The format for the day is as follows:

| by 8.00 am | Arrive at SMSPP. Tell the gate-person you are attending the MX-5 Club motorkhana. Proceed through tunnel to Skid Pan on the right (opposite Medical Centre). Follow the crowd to find a spot to park, and empty your car of any loose objects. Walk to the shelter adjacent to the skidpan for driver registration, issuing of licenses etc. |
| 8.00 am | Scrutineering check of vehicles starts. |
| 8:45 am | Drivers briefing. |
| 9.00 am | Commence Motorkhana Events on the Skid Pan |
| approx 12.30 pm | Lunch Break – Bring your own picnic lunch or purchase food from the cafe. |
| 1.15 pm | Continue Motorkhana Events |
| 4.00 pm | Close of day - Debrief |

Cars

When presented for scrutineering all vehicles must:

- Be in sound mechanical condition, with no fluid leaks
- Have the interior, glovebox and boot cleared of any loose items
- Be in a road-worthy condition (eg legal tyre tread depth)

It is not required to fit tow hooks, additional bonnet latches, blue battery triangles.

Drivers

Drivers must wear sensible clothing and shoes. A helmet is not required.

What to bring on the day!

- Club membership card if you are a car club member,
- CAMS license, unless you indicated on the entry form that you require an L1 license for the day,
- Registered or road worthy motor vehicle, preferable an MX-5!

- Comfortable and sensible clothing and shoes,
- A hat, sunscreen and plenty of water, as it may be a hot day and there is limited shade at the skid pan
- Your lunch, or money to buy lunch
