## **Motorkhana Practise Day**

**Sunday, 16<sup>th</sup> March 2013 at the Sydney Motor Sport Park Skid Pan**

Entrants must either show a CAMS License (L2NS, L2S or better) and a car club membership card, or have indicated on their entry form that they require a CAMS L1 license for the day. An Australian Auto-Sport Alliance (AASA) license is not acceptable for this event.

The motorkhana will be a non-competitive, with no official timing or prizes. This is to allow for the relaxed licensing restrictions necessary so that L1 licenses can be issued for the day of the event to motorsport newcomers.

The motorkhana activities will be selected to not be hard on your vehicles, so bring your MX-5 or family hack, but preferably your MX-5 as they are great for motorkhanas.

### **The format for the day is as follows:**

| 8.00 am  | Arrive at Sydney Motor Sport Park (entry through Gate 7) and proceed through tunnel to Skid Pan on the right (opposite Medical Centre). Empty vehicles of all loose objects. Report to Event Secretary for processing of entries, issuing of licenses etc. |
| 8.15 am  | Scrutineering check of vehicles starts.  |
| 9.15 am  | Drivers briefing.  |
| 9.30 am  | Commence Motorkhana Events on the Skid Pan   |
| 12.30 pm | Lunch Break – Bring your own picnic lunch or purchase food from the canteen.   |
| 1.30 pm  | Continue Motorkhana Events   |
| 4.00 pm  | Close of day - Debrief   |

### **Cars**

All vehicles must be either road-registered, or road-registerable. When presented for scrutineering they must:

- Be in sound mechanical condition, with no fluid leaks
- Have the interior, glovebox and boot cleared of any loose items
- Be in a road-worthy condition (eg legal tyre tread depth)

It is not required to fit tow hooks, additional bonnet latches, blue battery triangles.

### **Drivers**

Drivers must wear non-flammable clothing (ie no nylon or similar material), including cover from throat to wrists to ankles, and enclosed footwear. A helmet is not required.

### **What to bring on the day!**

- Club membership card if you are a car club member,
- CAMS license, unless you indicated on the entry form that you required an L1 license for the day,
- Completed CAMS disclaimer form for each driver,
- Registered or road worthy motor vehicle,
- Comfortable long sleeved shirt, long pants and shoes (clothing must be non-synthetic)

- A hat, sunscreen and plenty of water, as it may be a hot day and there is limited shade at the skid pan
- Your lunch, or money to buy lunch
