1. This event will be known as "Motorkhana Practice Day" hereafter referred to as THE EVENT.

Authority: The event is held under the FIA International Sporting Code (ISC), the CAMS National Competition Rules (NCR), the National Motorkhana Code, the CAMS Passenger In Vehicle Guidelines, the CAMS Come and Try Policy, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Further Regulations issued by the organising club. This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

The CAMS permit will be displayed at the start of the event.

8. Event Format: Non-competitive club motorkhana

PRIZES & TROPHIES As this is a non-competitive event there will be no Prizes or Trophies

9. Entry Fee: \$50 for MX-5 club members, \$75 for non-members

10. Entries

- a) Maximum number of entries for the Event: 40 Reserves: 5
- b) Maximum number of drivers per vehicle is two. (2)
- c) Opening Date: 26th May 2015
- d) Closing Date: 5:00 pm 23rd June 2015

- e) Entries will be accepted in order of receipt, and must be sent to the Event Secretary on a properly completed Entry Form accompanied by the appropriate fee paid by Cheque or Credit Card to the Organising Club.
- f) Entries from people under 18 years of age must be counter-signed/consented by a parent or legal guardian.
- g) If an entrant advises the event secretary that he/she is unable to attend the event, the following procedure regarding a refund applies: **at the organiser discretion.**
- h) Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- **11. Tests:** As per the current CAMS Motorkhana Handbook. Drivers will be advised of the selected tests at the drivers briefing.

12. Number of supervisors: 10

Qualifications - Club Approved (Min L2S licence holders, min 3 years motor sport experience)

13. Minimum licences:

CAMS current L2NS/L2NSJ or Superior with current membership of a CAMS affiliated club, otherwise a CAMS L1 Come & Try for the day of the event, issued once only at the event at a cost of \$25.

Drivers with L2NS/L2NSJ or Superior licences, must present their licence and current club membership during registration.

Please notify the event secretary if you require an L1 license.

14. Driver Safety.

- a) Maximum Speed 80 K P H.
- b) All apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport
 - 1. Minimum of short sleeve shirt/t-shirt and short pants.
 - 2. Enclosed shoes (thongs, open sandals, and high-heeled shoes are forbidden).
 - 3. A helmet is not mandatory except for drivers of Motorkhana Specials. If a helmet is worn, is required to meet the AS1698 standard.

15. Vehicle Check Requirements Basic vehicle safety check

- a) Vehicles to be in a roadworthy condition.
- b) Maximum noise limit: 95 dba at 30 metres.

 Any car found to exceed the maximum noise emission limit will be suspended from the Event until the Clerk if the Course is satisfied that action has been taken to bring it within the limit.
- c) Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- d) All vehicles shall comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

16. Vehicle Check

Start time: 8:00 am Finish time: 8.45 am

Location: On the skid pan

Note: Checking will cease while Drivers Briefing is held.

17. Drivers' Briefing is compulsory (**all** participants must attend and sign attendance sign-on sheet). Failure to attend or sign on may exclude the driver from the program.

Time: 8.45 am Venue: At the shelter beside the skidpan

18. Event Schedule Start time: 9.00 am Finish time: 4:00 pm.

19. Authority of officials.

Any competitor not following a reasonable instruction by an official during the Event may be excluded.

20. Insurance.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at www.cams.com.au.

- **21.** Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- **22. Postponement** *I* **abandonment** *I* **cancellation.** The organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- 23. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances: Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
- **24. Refreshment facilities:** Available at venue.
- **25.** Additions and/or alterations. Any additions and/or alterations to these Supplementary Regulations will be notified to all entrants in Final Regulations or during the Drivers' Briefing.
- 26. Vehicles must be road registered or be suitable with respect to safety standards that they could be road registered. Open Wheeler or single seater type vehicles are not permitted without the approval of the Clerk of Course.
