

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS (Draft)

MAZDA MX-5 CLUB OF NSW MOTORKHANA

1. Authority: The Event is held under the FIA International Sporting Code including Appendices and the National Competition Rules (NCR) of CAMS, the National Motorkhana Code, The CAMS Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) Policy, the CAMS Come and Try Policy, these Supplementary Regulations, and any Further Regulations issued by the organising club.

This Event will be conducted under and in accordance with CAMS OH&S, CAMS Safety 1st and Risk Management Policies, which can be found on the CAMS website at www.cams.com.au.

This Event will be known as Multi-Club Motorkhana hereafter referred to as The Event.

2. CAMS Permit No 219/1407/03

The CAMS Permit will be displayed at the start of the Event.

9. Entry Fee: \$70 for MX-5 Club Members, \$90 for Non-Members

10. Entries

- a) Maximum number of entries for the Event: 40 Reserves: 5
- b) Maximum number of Drivers per vehicle is two. (2)
- c) Opening Date: Sunday 16th June 2019
- d) Closing Date: 5:00 pm Sunday 7th July 2019
- e) Entries will be accepted in order of receipt and must be lodged via the CAMS Event Entry system along with payment of the appropriate fee by online credit card payment or by a cheque to the Organising Club.

- f) Entries from people under 18 years of age must be counter-signed/consented by a Parent or Legal Guardian.
- g) If an entrant advises the Event secretary that he/she is unable to attend the Event, the following procedure regarding a refund applies: at the Organiser discretion.
- h) Entries may be refused in accordance with NCR 83 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

11. Tests:

As per the current CAMS Motorkhana Handbook. Drivers will be advised of the selected tests at the Drivers Briefing.

12. Minimum licences:

CAMS current L2NS/L2NSJ or superior CAMS license with current membership of a CAMS affiliated club, otherwise a CAMS Come & Try license for the day of the Event. A CAMS Come and Try license is available for \$25, only to Entrants who do not already hold a CAMS competition license, and is valid only for one day, and for one Event a year. If you require a Come and Try license you must indicate that is so in your entry, and pay the additional \$25 along with the entry fee.

Drivers with L2NS/L2NSJ or Superior licences, must present their licence, current club membership and CAMS Log Book (if issued) during registration.

13. Driver Safety.

- a) Maximum Speed 80 Kph on the competition surface, walking pace elsewhere at the Event venue.
- b) All apparel shall comply with Schedule D of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport
 - 1. Minimum of short sleeve shirt/t-shirt and short pants.
 - 2. Enclosed shoes (thongs, open sandals, and high-heeled shoes are forbidden).

3. A helmet is not mandatory except for Drivers of Motorkhana Specials. If a helmet is worn, it is required to meet the CAMS Manual Schedule D and AS1698 standard.

14. Juniors.

Junior Drivers (ie under 16 years of age as of the date of the Event) will be required to carry a Parent or Guardian as a Passenger until Event officials are satisfied with their driving capabilities. That Parent or Guardian must be the person who signed giving consent for the Junior on their CAMS Disclaimer Form. Refer to article 27 of these Supplementary Regulations.

15. Vehicle Check Requirements Basic vehicle safety check

- a) All vehicles shall comply with Schedule A and Group 4H of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- b) Vehicles to be in a roadworthy condition.
- c) Maximum noise limit: 95 dba at 30 metres. Any car found to exceed the maximum noise emission limit will be suspended from the Event until the Clerk of the Course is satisfied that action has been taken to bring it within the limit.
- d) Fuel must be in accordance with Schedule G of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.

16. Scrutiny Check

Start time: 7:30 am Finish time: 8.45 am Location: On the skid pan <u>Note:</u> Checking will cease while Drivers Briefing is held.

- **17. Drivers Briefing** is compulsory (**all** Participants must attend and sign attendance sign-on sheet). Failure to attend or sign on may exclude the Driver from the program.
- . Time: 8.45 am Venue: At the shelter beside the skidpan
- **18.** Event Schedule Start time: **9.00 am** Finish time: **4:00 pm**.

19. Authority of officials.

Any Competitor not following a reasonable instruction by an official during the Event may be excluded.

20. Insurance.

Certain public, property, professional indemnity and personal accident insurance is provided by CAMS in relation to the Event. Further details can be found in the CAMS Insurance Handbook, available at <u>www.cams.com.au</u>.

- 21. Protests must be lodged in accordance with Part XII of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- 22. Postponement/abandonment/cancellation. The Organisers reserve the right to postpone, abandon or cancel the Event in accordance with NCR 59 of the current CAMS Manual of Motor Sport.
- 23. Alcohol, Drugs and Other Substances: Any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may be tested for the presence of drugs (or other banned substances) and subject to a penalty(ies) for a breach in accordance with the CAMS Anti-Doping Policy and/or the CAMS Illicit Drugs in Sport (Safety Testing) Policy as published on the CAMS website. Consumption of alcohol in the paddock, pits or any section of the competition venue/course under the control of the Officials is forbidden until all competition is concluded each day. Accordingly, any holder of a CAMS 'Competition' or 'Officials' licence (or equivalent licence issued by another ASN) may also be tested for the presence of alcohol by a CAMS Accredited Testing Official (CATO) in accordance with the CAMS Standard Operating Procedure for Breath Alcohol Testing.
- 24. Refreshment facilities: Available at venue.
- **25.** Additions and/or alterations. Any additions and/or alterations to these Supplementary Regulations will be notified to all entrants in Final Regulations or during the Drivers Briefing.
- **26.** Vehicles must be road registered or have a current CAMS log book. Open Wheeler, single seater type vehicles or motorkhana specials are not permitted without the prior approval of the Event Secretary or the Clerk of Course.

27. Passengers

This Event will include a Motor Sport Passenger Ride Activity (MSPRA) which shall be run under and in accordance with the CAMS MSPRA Policy.

Passengers are allowed to accompany a driver as a trainer or an observer. An insurance waiver must be signed prior to commencement of competition, and, at no time are they allowed to drive the vehicle unless they have entered the event and have the appropriate licensing. Only one passenger is allowed in any vehicle at any time during competition.

There is no penalty for a driver that carries a passenger (The driver will be eligible to score points in the MX-5 Club Championship) Note: Passengers must wear the same safety apparel as the driver which is appropriate for the class the vehicle is being competed in. The passenger must be restrained as required for each Automobile with consideration for their physical attributes. Vehicles shall only carry one Passenger at a time.
