## Captain's Report for the Year 2015-2016

Last year may have been a big year in the areas in which I have a responsibility that included the 25th Anniversary. However, 2016 had more social runs and events than 2015 and the *President's Picnic* at Ebenezer Church was the next biggest event is the Club's History. Our Club is dependent on the support of its members and this year our members stepped up again, some old and many new members have given their time for the benefit of others for which I thank them all on your behalf.
