<u>Treasurers Report for Financial Year ended 30 June 2022</u> Mazda MX-5 Club of NSW Inc

Thank you to all members and sponsors who have supported the Mazda MX-5 Club of NSW Inc (the Club) over the uncertainty of the past few years and indeed, the last 12 months of this report.

Enclosed is a copy of the Profit and Loss and Balance Sheet Report of the Mazda MX-5 Club of NSW for the year 2022-23 as generated by the Sage One ERP system and audited by Stanley and Stewart Chartered Accountants.

Track income & expenses are being recorded on a per event basis for FY2022-23, to assist in the reconciliation to Motorsport officials' records.

Looking forward, the 2023 financial year, I anticipate that there will be further pressure on motorsport financial performance with restricted locations (due to Wakefield's closure) and cost of living pressures.

The reports presented, I believe present a true and fair representation of the Club's performance over the financial year. However, it should be noted that I took over the role of Treasurer mid-July 2022 and to-date do not have access to the records of the Club beyond those held within the Sage One ERP.

The Club is a not-for-profit organisation. Members should not be concerned that making a \$44K profit is not allowed. Not-for-profit means that the entity is prohibited from distributing any profits to the members via a dividend (and this is also stated in the Constitution). It does not prohibit the Club from making profits and building up reserves. It is in the best interests of the Club to build and retain reserves sufficient to allow the Club to survive during hard times where it may incur significant losses.
