It's now less than four months until the Natmeet in the Barossa Valley and I hope you are all getting as excited as we are. We are still receiving enquiries to join and the good news is that there are still opportunities to enjoy this event if you have not already booked. For those of you who have registered and paid your first deposit, please be reminded that the final deposit balance is due on 29th December. Please refer payment details below. Anyone registering from that date will require full payment. Thank you to everyone who has already paid their full registrations.

For the motorsport enthusiasts we need to advise you that some alterations are in progress which have occurred due to factors beyond our control as described in the following report. We will keep you informed as developments

NatMeet 2018 Motorsport Update

1. Background

As many of you will be aware, we had planned to commence NatMeet 2018 with a day of motorsport at Mallala Motorsport Park on Sunday the 8th of April. The venue was booked and arrangements made to incorporate MX5 only runs in conjunction with MSCASA's Supersprint Round 1.

Our booking was confirmed by both MSCASA – who very kindly scheduled their event to coincide with NatMeet 2018 – and by the new owners of Mallala. Unfortunately, we've subsequently been advised that Mallala have moved our booking in favour of a 3 day event. The revised dates that they offered are regrettably not within our required time frame and as such we have had no option but to seek alternative venues.

The following is an update of what has transpired since, together with some information re the options that we are now pursuing.

2. The Bend Motorsport Park

The new owners of Mallala Motorsport Park are also the developers of "The Bend" – a new 200 million dollar state of the art Motorsport Complex which is currently under construction at Tailem Bend – about an hour South East of Adelaide. This is a world standard FIA licensed track that while predominately intended for circuit racing also caters for many other forms of motorsport including off roading, drifting & drag racing etc. There are 7.5 kms of newly laid bitumen circuit options, an airstrip & high end pits/ corporate accommodation. The hotel chain "Rydges" are currently constructing an onsite hotel complex which is reported to have been modelled on their Bathurst establishment. In summary, The Bend is high class and unquestionably world standard in all respects. The Motorsport Complex and the new Rydges Hotel are both scheduled to open in early April 2018.



We've been fortunate to secure a tentative booking at The Bend - together with the BMW Club of Victoria – for a Supersprint on Sunday the 8th of April 2018 with provisos that 1) Construction continues to run to schedule (highly likely as Shannons' Nationals are to be held there on April the 13th) and 2) That cost is not prohibitive. Costs are yet to be confirmed pending participation from other car clubs etc.

If this venue is confirmed, this will be a coup for NatMeet 2018 in that we will most probably be the first to compete at what promises to be an amazing – and in all likelihood, a highly publicised venue.



3. Other Possibilities

As a backup, the NatMeet Motorsport Committee are investigating other options – including runs at Collingrove Hill climb. Collingrove is a well known hill-climb venue which has the advantage of being close to the Barossa Valley – the area in which NatMeet 2018 will be based. This picturesque course has good facilities and is a very popular venue for Club Motorsport. The Sporting Car Club of SA is hosting an open meeting on the day, an event that is likely to attract competitors from a variety of local Car Clubs. We will keep you informed of progress but can assure you that we are doing all within our power to ensure that NatMeet 2018 will commence with an enjoyable day of competitive motorsport. We look forward to seeing you there.

Day 1 Sunday 8th April PM

Registration at the Novotel commence from 2.00pm followed by the evening welcome gourmet BBQ and drinks



Day 2* Monday 9th April * Note Runs on days 2, 4 and 5 will be a third of the total participants to each destination. Travel through the Barossa Valley to the Clare Valley through Auburn and on to a light lunch at O'Leary Walker Winery with spectacular views over the valley.



Return to the Barossa Valley before freshening up and boarding the bus for Seppeltsfield where you will be given a tour of the winery and their port barrel rooms, followed by welcoming drinks and nibbles before dinner. Sufficient time will be available to clean cars for the next day before boarding the bus.

There will be a silent auction on this evening with funds raised for some very deserving charities so please come prepared for some great opportunities to purchase some fantastic items.



Day 3 Tuesday 10th April

Today starts with a grand parade through Tanunda in the heart of the Barossa ending at Tanunda oval for a Concours de Elegance where participants can choose to have their cars judged. This will be a picnic atmosphere including morning tea and lunch provided by local community volunteers. The afternoon and evening are free for you to explore the wineries, craft and food establishments at your own pace.





Day 4* Wednesday 11th April

Today's run will explore the Barossa Valley including visits to Maggie Beer's, Wolf Blass winery and Barossa Valley Cheese Company and includes lunch at the SA Company Store famous for its local produce. Driving through the towns of Nuriootpa, Greenock, Angaston, Tanunda, Bethany and Seppeltsfield you will experience the many vineyards in their autumn colours. After lunch activities are free choice to explore the towns of Angaston, Nuriootpa or Tanunda before returning to the Novotel or simply chill out by the pool before boarding the bus to the Vine Inn in Nuriootpa for a dinner dance featuring a night of German theme and entertainment. Yes, dress code for the night is German theme so pack those lederhosen.



Day 5* Thursday 12th April

This morning we will enjoy some great roads through the Adelaide Hills before stopping for morning coffee at Oakbank famous for the annual steeplechase races.
